Announcement: Luxembourg Open Air (“LOA”) Festival 2021 will be postponed to 11 and 12 September 2021 due to the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic.

In light of the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic in Luxembourg, the LOA organization has decided to postpone the music festival Luxembourg Open Air from 24 and 25 April 2021 to 11 and 12 September 2021 in order to guarantee the health and safety of the visitors, artists and staff at LOA.

The LOA Festival in September 2021 will host the same Line-Up and headliners which were initially scheduled for September 2020 and April 2021 respectively. These include *Quintino, Michael Calfan, Justin Mylo, Danko, Smack and Iceleak*. More information on the first phase headliners performing at LOA can be found at the end of this document. In addition, all the amenities will remain unchanged, visitors will have the same experience they were supposed to have in April.

All the already purchased tickets will remain valid for LOA on the 11 and 12 September 2021. In case visitors have already purchased tickets for LOA but won't be able to attend the edition in September 2021, they have the option of changing the name on the ticket. Quintino

Known as a highly talented Dutch DJ and producer, Quintino has become one of the leading forces in the global dance music scene today. Working with legendary names like Tiësto, Dimitri Vegas & Like Mike, Steve Aoki, Afrojack and Hardwell, this is an artist who gets his career boosted year by year. Now catapulted onto the international scene, Michael Calfan has been recognized by the most important DJ's in the world as one of the most promising artists of his generation.
